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The **Abstract** word limit is 250 not including title, authors, affiliations, local mentor, APGO advisor and key words.

**All Abstracts should begin with the following:**

*Title:*

*Authors:* to determine eligibility for authorship use the criteria recommended by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (<http://www.icmje.org>)

*Affiliations:*

*Local Mentor:*

*APGO Advisor:*

*Key Words:* 3-5 key words or phrases

**Evidence-Based Education Project:**

*Problem:* Briefly state the practical learning or performance gap addressed by the intervention.

*Intervention:* Briefly describe the intervention, specifying how it addresses the practical problem.

*Context:* Briefly summarize the context in which the intervention was implemented.

*Outcome/Lessons Learned:* Briefly describe what happened to the educational process and outcomes when the intervention was implemented.

**Research Project:**

*Objective:* Main question, objective or hypothesis. Single phrase, e.g., “To estimate” or “To evaluate . . .”

*Methods:* Study design, participants, independent variable (intervention, predictor, exposure) and outcome measures, statistical analysis and, in the case of a negative study, statistical power.

*Results:* Measurements expressed in absolute numbers and percentages, and when appropriate indicate relative risks or odds ratios with confidence intervals and levels of significance. Do not include tables or figures.

*Conclusion:* Directly supported by the data, along with implications.

**Literature Review Abstract:**

*Objective:* State the purpose of the review.

*Data Sources:* Sources searched including dates, terms and constraints.

*Methods of Study Selection:* Number of studies reviewed and selection criteria.

*Tabulation, Integration and Results:* Guidelines for extracting data and methods of correlating (if applicable), and results of review.

*Conclusion:* Primary conclusions and their applications.
