5	Please start the program at 9am so that we can exercise and not wake up at 5am to do so. Please put in half day sessions in each of the gathering meetings for small groups to talk about career related issues and do near peer mentoring. This should be an entire afternoon at fds, caam and in the August session. It can have small group facilitation with questions for the groups but so many people are going through difficult decision making and issues with program leadership/politics/transitions that we need to have this formally incorporated instead of happening over cocktails and dinner. I recommend a career panel with chairs, deans, to talk about their experiences in these roles, what does a day look like etc, who should do that job and why. This should replace the anatomy of the deans office lecture which was also not high yield. Finally, I wish the experience was divided into education / curriculum building and leadership skills training thematically. Maybe start with the curriculum building and planning projects then move into the leadership training, networking, negotiating, coaching. The cohort is mostly mid career and these components were very high yield and everyone wanted more of this. Writing mission, vision value statements or education statements for promotion packets may be a good topic as a lot of people are prepping for promotion.
